We will also facilitate digital studies for exchange students who, for various reasons, will not be able to study in Oslo in the spring semester 2021, as long as your home institution will allow remote studies.

We are now in the process of preparing the course offer for the spring semester 2021, and the semester start, which will most likely be digital. Further information about the semester start will be sent you as soon as possible.

Most law courses will begin from the week starting 25 January, and digital introduction activities will start from the beginning of January (not compulsory). The websites and timetables for courses will be updated from the end of November, and you may then start to register for courses in Student web. Law students on the Erasmus programme/bilateral agreements and Nord-Plus students who have completed two years of law studies or more are welcome to register for law courses at master's

level. Please check with your exchange coordinator at your home university whether you are supposed to register for courses at bachelor's or master's level. (A number of courses are available at master's level only, see the list)

You are expected to choose **three full courses in one semester** (30 ECTS). The Faculty does reserve the right to cancel options if the number of students wishing to follow the course is insufficient. The semester webpages will be updated from December 1 for the spring semester 2021.

Course pre-registration in nomination web is not binding; you are free to make changes before 1 February. However, if you register early on-line you may have a better chance of being admitted to the courses you wish to take. Criminology courses and courses offered at other faculties have usually limited places (or special regulations due to the pandemic), so we advise you to check/register quickly to have a place. Please note also that in some courses a letter of motivation must be submitted on-line (JUS5671/1671 and jus 5911 for the pilot project), please read carefully the websites for these courses. The **deadline for final registration for courses and exams** for the spring semester 2021 (done online in Studentweb) is **February 1st**. Studentweb opens approx. **1 December** for on-line course registration!

You may have your learning agreement signed by sending it to info@jus.uio.no, which is the Info Centre at the Faculty of Law. Please check with your home university which documents you need, and we will then sign them. See the enclosed list with courses offered in the spring semester.
