


Seminar 17. november kl 12-13: Intimacy and Equality in the Sharing Economy

- Prof. Naomi Schoenbaum, George Washington University
- "The intimacy on which many sharing-economy transactions are premised holds both promise and peril for those concerned with race and gender equality.
- Expanding on previous research on intimate work—a critical area that exists largely in limbo between the law of the market and the law of the family—this talk will explore the significance of intimacy in the sharing economy and the implications for regulation of the sharing economy and for equality. The intimacy of many sharing-economy transactions heightens the salience of identity to these transactions, in tension with anti-discrimination law's goal of reducing the salience of identity in the labor market.
- Sharing-economy platforms have increasingly come to address discrimination by reducing the
 intimacy of transactions, especially by making transactions more anonymous. But this comes at a
 cost, not only for those who prefer the intimacy that the sharing economy offers, but also by
 foregoing an opportunity to combat discrimination in a way that changes hearts and minds.
